In 2018, with her Pastor's blessing, Kelli felt the call to transition to Victory in Christ Christian Center located in Westville, NJ, where Bishop John and Pastor Isha Edmondson are her Pastors. Kelli is currently the Director of Victorious Women of Victory (VWV) Women's Ministry and serves on the Intensified Prayer Team. Kelli's leadership of the women's ministry during the COVID-19 pandemic proved her strong leadership skills were both strong and pliable.

With a heart of compassion to see all women, of all ages, and from all levels of society, not only healed, but made whole; in 2020, Kelli authored a devotional for women called, “Love Evolving: A 21-Day Journey into the Father's Heart”.

Kelli is currently preparing to launch her own personal ministry called Woman2Woman, LLC, which, God birthed out of a season of great pain and despair.
